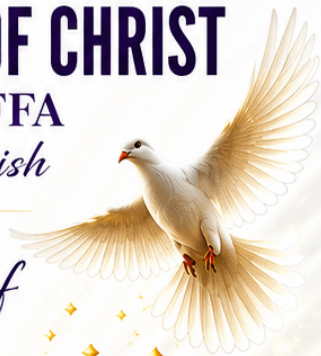

Read the Scripture, receive the Word, declare the declarations aloud, and pray the prayers expecting an overflow of God's grace.

DAY 1

The God of All Grace

SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 2026 · 6:30 PM

Opening Prayer

Heavenly Father, we come before You on this Day 1 of our 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. We thank You for bringing us to this point. As we open Your Word tonight under the theme of "The God of All Grace", let Your Spirit move mightily. Let every heart receive what You have prepared. Let every prayer be heard in heaven. Let every declaration produce results in the natural realm. We give You all the glory in advance. In the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

The Word — “Grace — The Foundation of Everything”

Welcome to the first day of 21 Days of Word, Declaration, and Prayer of Overflowing Grace. Tonight we begin a journey that will transform your life, your family, your ministry, and your future. But before we can experience the overflow of grace, we must first understand its source. Grace does not flow from human effort, religious performance, or spiritual achievement. Grace flows from God — the God of all grace. Tonight we lay the foundation. We establish in our hearts and minds who God is in the context of this 21-day season. He is not just a God who occasionally shows grace — He is the GOD OF ALL GRACE. Grace is not something He does — it is something He IS.

1. God Is the Source of All Grace. Our primary text tonight declares that God is 'able to make all grace abound toward you.' The word 'abound' in the Greek is 'perisseuo' — meaning to overflow, to exceed, to be in excess, to be more than enough. God does not give grace sparingly. God does not ration grace. God makes grace ABOUND — overflow — exceed every measure — toward you. The foundation of these 21 days is this: there is no situation in your life that is beyond the reach of God's abounding grace. Financial crisis? Grace abounds. Family breakdown? Grace abounds. Health emergency? Grace abounds. Ministry challenge? Grace abounds. Personal failure? Grace abounds.

2. Grace Provides All Sufficiency. The text says 'always having all sufficiency in all things.' Notice the repetition of the word 'all' — all sufficiency, all things, abound to every good work. God's grace does not cover some areas of your life and leave others exposed. His grace is comprehensive, complete, and all-encompassing. The word 'sufficiency' in the Greek is 'autarkeia' — meaning self-sufficiency, contentment, a perfect condition of life in which no aid or support is needed. When grace is operating in your life, you have an inner sufficiency that is not dependent on external circumstances.

3. Grace Equips You for Every Good Work. The ultimate purpose of grace is not simply to make your life comfortable — it is to equip you for every good work. Grace is not passive — it is productive. Grace is not just about receiving — it is about being empowered to give, to serve, to build, and to impact the world around you. These 21 days are not just about personal blessing — they are about being equipped and commissioned for the work God has called you to do.

Prayer of Response

Lord God, I come before You at the beginning of this 21-day journey. I acknowledge You as the God of all grace. I declare that Your grace is sufficient for everything in my life. I receive Your grace afresh tonight — not because I deserve it, but because You are the God of all grace and Your grace abounds toward me. I commit to these 21 days with an open heart, ready to receive everything You have prepared for me. Let Your grace overflow in my life, my family, my work, and my ministry. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that God is the God of ALL grace and His grace abounds toward me.
- ❖ I have all sufficiency in all things through the grace of God.
- ❖ I am equipped for every good work by the overflow of His grace.
- ❖ This 21-day journey is transforming my life from the inside out.
- ❖ Grace is not just what God gives me — grace is how God defines me.
- ❖ I am a receiver of overflowing grace and a carrier of His abundance.
- ❖ From Grace to Grace — I overflow! In Jesus' name. Amen!

Prayer Points

1. **Thanksgiving for His Grace.** Father, we thank You for the gift of Your grace that has brought us to this first day of 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. We thank You that You are not a God who withholds good things from Your children. We thank You that Your grace abounds toward us. We worship You as the God of all grace — the source of everything we need. In Jesus' name. Amen.
2. **Fresh Revelation of Grace.** Holy Spirit, we ask for a fresh revelation of what grace truly means for our lives during these 21 days. Remove every wrong concept of grace. Correct every misunderstanding. Let us see grace the way You see it — as the complete sufficiency of God operating in every area of our lives. In Jesus' name. Amen.
3. **Grace for Every Participant.** Father, we pray for every person participating in this 21-day program — those present tonight and those joining from afar. Let Your grace reach them wherever they are. Let the overflow of these 21 days produce miracles, breakthroughs, and transformations in every life represented. In Jesus' name. Amen.
4. **Grace for the Church.** Lord, we pray for CCC Bilehou Oshoffa Miracle Land Parish. Let Your grace rest upon this church in a fresh and powerful way. Grace our shepherd, Avse Sanmi Dawodu, with wisdom, strength, and divine anointing for this season. Let every service, every prayer, and every declaration of these 21 days produce lasting fruit. In Jesus' name. Amen.
5. **Grace to Sustain the 21 Days.** Father, we declare that every person who begins this 21-day journey will finish it. We pray against every distraction, every discouragement, and every interruption the enemy may try to bring. Let grace sustain every participant from Day 1 to Day 21. Let them finish stronger than they started. In Jesus' name. Amen.

6. **Grace for Families.** Lord, we pray for every family represented in this congregation. Let Your grace flow through these 21 days into our homes. Let marriages be strengthened, children be blessed, and every household become a sanctuary of Your presence. In Jesus' name. Amen.

7. **Declaration of Overflow.** We declare over this entire 21-day season: Grace will abound. Grace will overflow. Grace will transform. Grace will heal. Grace will restore. Grace will promote. Grace will deliver. From Day 1 to Day 21 — from Grace to Grace — WE OVERFLOW! In Jesus' mighty name. Amen!

DAY 2

Grace for Salvation and Redemption

MONDAY, JUNE 22, 2026 · 6:30 PM

Opening Prayer

Heavenly Father, we come before You on this Day 2 of our 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. We thank You for bringing us to this point. As we open Your Word tonight under the theme of "Grace for Salvation and Redemption", let Your Spirit move mightily. Let every heart receive what You have prepared. Let every prayer be heard in heaven. Let every declaration produce results in the natural realm. We give You all the glory in advance. In the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Scripture

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast." —

Ephesians 2:8-9 (KJV)

Supporting Scriptures

The Word — “You Didn't Earn It — Grace Gave It!”

There is a question that has haunted humanity since the fall of man in the Garden of Eden: How can a sinful man stand before a holy God? The answer is not found in religion, ritual, or righteous deeds. The answer is found in one word — GRACE. Grace is the very heartbeat of God toward fallen humanity. Tonight on Day 2, we explore what it means to be saved by grace and redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ.

1. The Problem Grace Solved — Sin and Separation. For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). Sin separated us from God, sentenced us to death, and enslaved us to darkness. The wages of sin is death — but God in His infinite grace refused to leave us in that condition. Where sin abounded — grace did much more abound. Grace is always greater than sin. Grace is always more powerful than the problem it addresses.

2. How Grace Saved Us — The Work of Redemption. Redemption means to buy back, to ransom, to set free by paying a price. God became flesh through the Incarnation — full of grace and truth. On the cross, He paid the price for our redemption. Every stripe, every nail, every drop of blood was grace extended toward undeserving humanity. Through the Resurrection, He conquered death — proving that grace is not just sufficient for life, it is victorious over death itself.

3. Salvation Is By Grace Through Faith — Not Works. Ephesians 2:8-9 establishes three critical truths: Salvation is BY GRACE — it originates entirely in the heart of God. Salvation is THROUGH FAITH — faith is the hand that reaches out and receives the gift. Salvation is NOT OF WORKS — no man can boast before God about earning his salvation. It is a gift — and gifts are not earned, they are received with gratitude and humility.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, I come to You just as I am. I acknowledge that I am a sinner and that I cannot save myself. I believe that You died on the cross for my sins and rose again on the third day. I receive Your grace today. I accept You as my Lord and personal Saviour. Forgive me of all my sins and write my name in the Book of Life. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit and help me to live for You from this day forward. I am saved by grace. Thank You, Lord Jesus. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that I am saved by grace — not by my works or my efforts.
- ❖ The gift of salvation is mine — freely given and freely received.
- ❖ I walk in the fullness of redemption today.
- ❖ My past has been erased by the blood of Jesus and the power of His grace.
- ❖ I am a new creation — old things have passed away.
- ❖ I am no longer condemned — I am justified by faith.
- ❖ Grace found me, grace saved me, grace keeps me.
- ❖ I am saved. I am redeemed. I overflow with His grace. Amen!

Prayer Points

1. **Thanksgiving for Salvation.** Father, we thank You for the greatest gift ever given to humanity — the gift of salvation through Your Son Jesus Christ. We thank You that You did not leave us in our sin. We thank You for grace that found us when we were lost. We worship You for the blood of Jesus that washed us clean. In Jesus' name. Amen.

2. **Prayer for the Unsaved.** Father, we lift up every unsaved soul before Your throne of grace tonight. We pray for our family members, friends, colleagues, and neighbors who do not yet know You. Lord, let the same grace that saved us reach them. Draw them by Your Spirit. Soften hardened hearts. Let this 21-day program be a season of mass salvation. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.
3. **Deeper Revelation of Redemption.** Holy Spirit, we ask for a deeper revelation of what redemption means for our lives. Help us to truly understand the price that was paid for our freedom. Let the revelation of the blood of Jesus be fresh and powerful in our hearts. Give us a holy awe for the gift of salvation. In Jesus' name. Amen.
4. **Prayer for the Backslidden.** Lord Jesus, we pray for every backslider — those who once knew You and have drifted away. Father, let Your grace pursue them. Let Your Spirit draw them back. Remove the shame that keeps them from returning. Remind them that Your arms are still open wide. Let this be the season of their restoration and return. In Jesus' name. Amen.
5. **Breaking Generational Sin.** Father, in the name of Jesus, we come against every generational sin and iniquity passed down through our bloodlines. We apply the blood of Jesus to every generational pattern of sin, addiction, and darkness. We declare that the grace of redemption breaks every chain of generational bondage tonight. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.
6. **Freedom from Guilt and Condemnation.** Lord, we pray for every person carrying the weight of guilt and condemnation. Those who feel too sinful to be forgiven. Father, let Your Word speak to them: There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1). Let them receive the full forgiveness that grace provides. Set them free from the prison of guilt. In Jesus' name. Amen.

7. **Overflow of Salvation.** We declare over this 21-day season that salvation will overflow in our church, our community, and our city of Chicago. We decree that souls will be added to the Kingdom daily. We declare that testimonies of salvation will fill this house. From Grace to Grace — WE OVERFLOW! In Jesus' mighty name. Amen!

DAY 3

Grace for Strength in Weakness

TUESDAY, JUNE 23, 2026 · 6:30 PM

Opening Prayer

Heavenly Father, we come before You on this Day 3 of our 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. We thank You for bringing us to this point. As we open Your Word tonight under the theme of "Grace for Strength in Weakness", let Your Spirit move mightily. Let every heart receive what You have prepared. Let every prayer be heard in heaven. Let every declaration produce results in the natural realm. We give You all the glory in advance. In the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Scripture

"And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." — 2

Corinthians 12:9 (KJV)

Supporting Scriptures

The Word — “When You Are Empty, Grace Is Full”

There is a narrative that the world promotes that says strong people don't need help. Real faith means you never feel weak. But the Apostle Paul — who wrote two-thirds of the New Testament — said he gloried in his infirmities. Tonight we discover the most powerful secret in the Kingdom: when you are at your weakest, Grace is at its strongest.

1. The Context — Paul's Thorn and God's Answer. Paul had been given extraordinary revelations and along with them came a thorn in the flesh — painful, persistent, and powerful enough to make him feel weak. He prayed three times for its removal. God's answer was not removal — it was GRACE. Sometimes God does not remove the difficulty because He intends to demonstrate His glory through it. The thorn stays so that the grace can be seen. God's grace is not diminished by your thorn — it is magnified by it.

2. My Grace Is Sufficient — What Sufficiency Means. The word 'sufficient' in the Greek is 'arkei' — meaning to be completely, totally, absolutely, and overwhelmingly enough. God's grace is sufficient for your pain, your pressure, your past, and your purpose. It does not barely get you through — it overwhelmingly carries you through. Whatever you are facing tonight — God's grace is more than enough for it.

3. The Paradox — Strength Made Perfect in Weakness. God's strength is not made perfect in our strength — it is made perfect in our weakness. Why? So that the glory goes to God alone. So that we learn to depend on Him. And so that we become channels of grace to others who are weak. The person who has been broken and cried out to God in weakness becomes the greatest vessel through which God's grace flows to others.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, I come to You tonight in my weakness. I have been trying to be strong on my own and I am exhausted. I surrender every burden, every struggle, and every area where I have been striving in my own strength. I receive Your grace tonight as my sufficiency. I declare that Your strength is made perfect in my weakness. Fill me afresh with Your Holy Spirit. Let Your power rest upon me. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that God's grace is sufficient for every weakness I carry.
- ❖ Where I am weak — He is strong.
- ❖ Where I am empty — He is full.
- ❖ His strength is perfected in me right now.
- ❖ I mount up with wings as eagles. I run and do not grow weary.
- ❖ The power of Christ rests upon me.
- ❖ My weakness is not my end — it is my platform for His glory.
- ❖ Grace is my strength. Grace is my sufficiency. Grace is my overflow.
Amen!

Prayer Points

1. **Thanksgiving for Sustaining Strength.** Father, we thank You that You are the source of all strength. We thank You for every moment You carried us when we could not carry ourselves. We worship You as the God of all strength and the source of all grace. In Jesus' name. Amen.
2. **Physical Weakness and Illness.** Father, in the name of Jesus, we lift up every person battling physical weakness, sickness, and illness. Let Your

healing grace flow through every sick body tonight. Strengthen the weak. Energize the fatigued. We declare that by the stripes of Jesus, they are healed. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

3. **Emotional and Mental Weakness.** Lord Jesus, we pray for every person fighting a battle in their mind and emotions. Those wrestling with depression, anxiety, grief, and hopelessness. Let the peace that passes understanding guard their hearts and minds. Send Your Comforter to minister to every wounded emotion. In Jesus' name. Amen.
4. **Spiritual Renewal and Fresh Fire.** Holy Spirit, we pray for every believer who is spiritually dry and weary. Send a fresh wind of Your Spirit into this place. Revive the dying embers of passion in our hearts. Let Your grace be a fresh fire in our spirits. In Jesus' name. Amen.
5. **Against the Spirit of Discouragement.** Father, we come against every spirit of discouragement, despair, and defeat assigned against this congregation. We pull down every stronghold of hopelessness. We declare that we are not quitters — we are overcomers. Grace strengthens us to finish what God has started. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.
6. **Grace to Surrender Our Weakness.** Lord, we confess that many of us have been trying to be strong in our own power. Tonight we surrender. We lay down the weight of self-sufficiency. We lay down the pride that refuses to admit weakness. Fill us where we are empty. Strengthen us where we are weak. In Jesus' name. Amen.
7. **Declaration of Strength Through Grace.** We declare over every member of this congregation: You are not defined by your weakness — you are defined by the grace that covers your weakness. Every tired mother is strengthened by grace. Every struggling father is upheld by grace. Every weary soul finds rest in grace. From Grace to Grace — WE ARE STRONG! Amen!

DAY 4

Grace for Favor and Open Doors

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 24, 2026 · 6:30 PM

Opening Prayer

Heavenly Father, we come before You on this Day 4 of our 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. We thank You for bringing us to this point. As we open Your Word tonight under the theme of "Grace for Favor and Open Doors", let Your Spirit move mightily. Let every heart receive what You have prepared. Let every prayer be heard in heaven. Let every declaration produce results in the natural realm. We give You all the glory in advance. In the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen.

Scripture

"For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield." — Psalm 5:12 (KJV)

Supporting Scriptures

- *"Behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it." — Revelation 3:8 (KJV)*
- *"A man's gift maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men." — Proverbs 18:16 (KJV)*
- *"The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season." — Deuteronomy 28:12 (KJV)*

The Word — “Surrounded by Favor — Walking Through Open Doors”

Talent can get you to the door. Favor opens it. We live in a world that places enormous value on human qualifications — but when the favor of God is upon your life, the rules change entirely. Tonight on Day 4, we explore what it means to walk in the grace of divine favor and to step through doors that only God can open.

1. What Is Divine Favor?. The word 'favor' in Hebrew is 'Ratson' — meaning delight, pleasure, goodwill, acceptance, and the bending of the will of someone powerful toward you. Divine favor is when the Creator of the universe bends His will and attention toward you in a way that produces supernatural results. Favor is God's goodwill, supernatural advantage, divine access, and a shield that surrounds you on every side.

2. The Joseph Pattern — Favor Follows You. Joseph's life is the greatest demonstration of divine favor. In the pit, favor kept him alive. In Potiphar's house, favor elevated him from slave to overseer. In prison, the keeper favored him. Before Pharaoh, in one divine encounter, Joseph went from prisoner to the second most powerful man in Egypt. The lesson: your pit does not disqualify you from the palace. When God's favor is on your life, it follows you through every season.

3. The Key of David — Doors Only God Can Open. Jesus holds the Key of David — the key of supreme authority. He opens doors that are completely beyond human reach. Some doors men have shut against you — Jesus can reopen them. Some doors are not yet open because God has divine timing for them. And sometimes God shuts doors to protect and redirect us. Every door God closes is an act of grace leading toward something better.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, I come before You asking for Your favor to rest upon my life in a fresh and powerful way. I acknowledge that I cannot open the doors I need by my own strength alone. Let Your favor surround me like a shield. Go before me and prepare the way. Open doors that have been closed. Release blessings that have been delayed. Let every open door I walk through bring glory to Your name. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that the favor of God surrounds me like a shield today.
- ❖ I am highly favored of the Lord.
- ❖ Doors that were closed are opening before me right now.
- ❖ I walk into rooms of greatness and divine opportunity.
- ❖ Men and women of influence favor me.
- ❖ The Key of David is turning in every locked door of my life.

The Word — “God's Economy — Where Grace Produces Overflow”

Money is one of the most discussed topics in the Bible — Jesus spoke about it more than almost any other subject. Why? Because our relationship with finances reveals our relationship with God. Tonight on Day 5, we confront the spirit of poverty, challenge the theology of lack, and declare that God's grace produces financial overflow for His people.

1. God Gives Power to Get Wealth. Our text does not say God gives wealth directly — it says He gives the POWER to get wealth. This is significant. God's grace does not bypass your effort — it empowers your effort. God's grace does not replace your work — it supernaturally multiplies it. The power to get wealth includes wisdom, creativity, opportunities, divine connections, and supernatural favor in financial dealings.

2. The Spirit of Poverty Vs the Spirit of Grace. The spirit of poverty is not just the absence of money — it is a mindset that keeps people from receiving God's financial provision. Poverty thinking says: I will never have enough. Wealth is for other people. God wants me poor to keep me humble. Grace thinking says: My God shall supply ALL my need. I am blessed to be a blessing. God takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servant (Psalm 35:27).

3. Principles of Financial Grace. Grace-driven financial overflow is activated through: Tithing and giving — bringing all the tithes into the storehouse opens the windows of heaven. Faithful stewardship — being faithful with what God has given you positions you for more. Sowing in faith — he who sows bountifully shall reap bountifully (2 Corinthians 9:6). Divine wisdom in business and finances — seeking God's strategy over human methods alone.

Prayer of Response

Father, I come before You tonight as the God who gives power to get wealth. I repent of poverty thinking and any agreement I have made with lack and insufficiency. I declare that You are my Provider and the source of all my increase. I receive the grace to get wealth. I receive wisdom for financial decisions. I declare that debt is broken off my life and abundance is my covenant right. Let my finances overflow for Your glory. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

The Word — “Healing Is the Children's Bread”

When a Gentile woman came to Jesus for the healing of her daughter, Jesus said healing was the children's bread (Matthew 15:26). Not a luxury. Not a rare miracle. Not something reserved for a special few. Bread — the everyday staple, the daily provision. Tonight on Day 6, we declare that divine health and healing are not exceptional occurrences — they are grace-covenant realities for every child of God.

1. Healing Is in the Atonement. Isaiah 53:5 declares that with His stripes we are healed. This was not just a prediction — it was a covenant declaration. The same atonement that purchased our salvation also purchased our healing. Peter confirms it: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed (1 Peter 2:24). Healing was purchased at Calvary. It is not something to hope for — it is something to receive.

2. God's Nature Is to Heal. One of God's covenant names is Jehovah Rapha — I am the LORD that healeth thee. Healing is not just what God does — it is part of who He is. His nature is to heal. His instinct is to restore. His desire is for you to walk in divine health. Everywhere Jesus went, He healed. He healed the blind, the lame, the lepers, the deaf, and the dead. His healing ministry was a demonstration of His Father's nature — a God who heals ALL manner of sickness and disease.

3. Receiving Your Healing By Grace Through Faith. Healing, like salvation, is received by grace through faith. You do not earn healing by being good enough. You do not qualify for healing by your level of spirituality. Healing is a covenant right, received by faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ. Speak the Word over your body. Stand on the promises. Refuse to accept sickness as your permanent condition. Declare

that you are healed — not because you feel it yet, but because the Word of God says it.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, I come to You tonight as Jehovah Rapha — the God who heals. I believe that by Your stripes I am healed. I receive my healing by faith right now. I declare that sickness and disease have no covenant right to remain in my body. My body is the temple of the Holy Spirit and no infirmity shall dwell here permanently. I am healed. I am whole. I am healthy by the grace of God. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

1. God Is in the Business of Restoration. Joel 2:25 is one of the most powerful promises in Scripture. God promises to restore the years that the locust has eaten. This means everything that was stolen, damaged, or destroyed by the enemy's attacks on your family is subject to divine restoration. God does not just fix what is broken — He restores what was lost. He does not just repair marriages — He renews them. He does not just return prodigals — He transforms them.

2. The Grace-covered Home. Joshua declared: As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD. This was not just a personal decision — it was a household declaration. When the head of a home makes a covenant with God, that covenant covers the entire household. The grace of God flows through covenant. When you choose to serve God, His grace is released over your spouse, your children, your home, and your family legacy.

3. Grace for Prodigals and Broken Relationships. The story of the Prodigal Son is not really about the son — it is about the father's grace. When the son was still a great way off, the father saw him and ran to meet him (Luke 15:20). That is the grace of God toward every prodigal in your family. Before they turn around, God's grace is already running toward them. Your prayers for prodigal children and broken family relationships are not falling on deaf ears — God's grace is pursuing them.

Let Your grace fuel my growth. Let Your Spirit lead me into all truth. Let my knowledge of You deepen every day. Transform me from glory to glory. In Jesus' name. Amen.

- *"For the LORD your God is he that goeth with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you." — Deuteronomy 20:4 (KJV)*

The Word — “More Than Conquerors — Grace that Wins Every Battle”

The Christian life is not a playground — it is a battleground. But it is a battleground where the outcome has already been determined. Jesus Christ has already won the ultimate victory over sin, death, and the devil. Tonight on Day 9, we explore how the grace of God makes us not just victorious — but MORE THAN conquerors in every battle we face.

1. The Victory Has Already Been Won. And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it (Colossians 2:15). Jesus Christ defeated every principality and power at the cross. The enemy has already been defeated — he is just hoping you don't know it. Every spiritual battle you fight today is not a battle for victory — it is a battle from victory. You are not fighting to win — you are fighting because you have already won.

2. Your Weapons Are Grace-powered. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds (2 Corinthians 10:4). Our weapons are not human intellect, political influence, or physical force. Our weapons are the Word of God, prayer, praise, the blood of Jesus, and the name of Jesus. These are grace-powered weapons that are mighty through God for the destruction of every stronghold the enemy builds.

3. No Weapon Formed Against You Shall Prosper. Isaiah 54:17 is not a promise that weapons will not be formed — it is a promise that they will not prosper. The enemy will attack. He will form weapons of accusation, illness, financial pressure, family trouble, and spiritual discouragement. But by the grace of God, not one of these weapons will accomplish its intended purpose against you. They are formed — but they are futile. They are aimed — but they are aimless. They are fired — but they fall short.

Prayer of Response

Father, I thank You that the victory has already been won through Jesus Christ. I declare tonight that I am more than a conqueror. I stand against every weapon formed against me and I declare it will not prosper. I resist the devil in the name of Jesus and he must flee. I walk in the victory that grace provides — not by my strength but by the power of the blood of Jesus. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that no weapon formed against me shall prosper.
- ❖ Every tongue that rises against me in judgment is condemned.
- ❖ I am more than a conqueror through Christ who loves me.
- ❖ The enemy has no power over my life, my destiny, or my family.

The Word — “Heaven Responds When You Pray”

Prayer is not a religious formality — it is a divine communication system between earth and heaven. Tonight on Day 10, we are at the midpoint of our 21-day journey, and this is the perfect time to focus on the grace that makes our prayers effective — the grace of a God who hears, who answers, and who shows great and mighty things to those who call upon Him.

1. God's Promise Is to Answer. Jeremiah 33:3 is sometimes called 'God's telephone number.' Call unto me — and I WILL answer. Not 'I might answer.' Not 'I will answer if you are good enough.' Not 'I will answer when I feel like it.' I WILL answer — it is a covenant promise. God is not silent. God is not absent. God is not indifferent to your prayers. He has made an unconditional commitment to answer when you call.

2. The Throne of Grace — Access for All. Hebrews 4:16 invites us to come BOLDLY to the throne of grace. Not tentatively. Not reluctantly. Not with shame and inadequacy. BOLDLY — with confidence, assurance, and expectation. And notice what the throne is called — the THRONE OF GRACE. Not the throne of judgment. Not the throne of performance evaluation. The throne of GRACE — where mercy and help are freely available. Every prayer you pray goes directly to a throne of grace.

3. Great and Mighty Things — Beyond Your Imagination. God's promise in Jeremiah 33:3 is not just to answer your prayers — it is to show you great and mighty things which thou knowest not. Things you have not yet imagined. Solutions you have not yet conceived. Breakthroughs that are beyond the scope of your current thinking. When you pray, God does not just meet your expectations — He exceeds them. Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him (1 Corinthians 2:9).

Prayer of Response

Father, I come boldly to Your throne of grace tonight. I declare that my prayers are heard. I declare that You are a God who answers. I bring every unanswered prayer and every long-standing petition before You tonight. I call upon You according to Jeremiah 33:3 and I expect You to answer and show me great and mighty things. The Word — “God's Elevator — Rising to Your God-Ordained Level”

Promotion is one of the most sought-after and most misunderstood concepts in human experience. People spend entire careers campaigning, networking, and maneuvering for promotion — only to find that the most significant elevations in life come not from human effort alone but from divine appointment. Tonight on Day 11, we discover that real promotion comes from God — and when God promotes, no man can demote.

1. True Promotion Is God's Domain. Psalm 75:6-7 establishes definitively that promotion does not come from the east, west, or south — meaning it does not come from human sources alone. God is the ultimate promoter. This does not mean human effort is irrelevant — it means that the final decision about your elevation belongs to God. You can position yourself, prepare yourself, and present yourself — but the appointment is God's. This is liberating because it means no human being has the final say over your destiny.

2. The Grace-humility Connection. The pathway to God-ordained promotion is humility. He giveth grace unto the lowly (Proverbs 3:34). Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God that He may exalt you in due time (1 Peter 5:6). In God's economy, the way up is the way down. The person who humbles themselves before God — serving faithfully, giving generously, working diligently without demanding recognition — is the person God chooses to elevate. Grace and humility walk hand in hand.

3. God's Promotion Is Complete and Lasting. When God promotes, He does it completely. Joseph went from prisoner to Prime Minister in one day. David went from shepherd to King through divine appointment. Esther went from orphan to Queen by divine providence. When God elevates you, He does not just move you one step higher — He positions you at the level He

has ordained for your life. And unlike human promotion, God's promotion comes with the grace to handle it.

Prayer of Response

Father, I acknowledge tonight that my promotion comes from You alone. I humble myself under Your mighty hand and I trust You to exalt me in due time. I will not campaign for what You have ordained — I will be faithful in what You have given me now. Let Your grace elevate me to the level You have prepared for me. The Word — “Supernatural Peace — Grace for the Storm”

The world searches desperately for peace — through medication, meditation, vacation, and distraction. But the peace that God gives is not found in any of these things. It is a peace that passes understanding — it does not make sense in the natural. It is the ability to be calm in a storm, joyful in a trial, and settled in uncertainty. Tonight on Day 12, we receive the grace of God's supernatural peace.

1. The Peace that Surpasses Understanding. The Greek word for peace in our text is 'eirene' — meaning to join, to bind together what has been separated, a state of tranquility and harmony. But Paul adds something remarkable — this peace 'passes all understanding.' It exceeds the capacity of human reason to explain it. How can someone be peaceful when they are facing financial ruin? How can someone be calm when they receive a terrible medical diagnosis? Because the peace of God is not produced by favorable circumstances — it is produced by the presence of God.

2. The Condition for Perfect Peace. Isaiah 26:3 reveals the condition: Thou wilt keep him in PERFECT peace, whose mind is STAYED on Thee. The condition for perfect peace is a mind that is stayed — fixed, focused, anchored — on God. The moment your mind shifts from God to the problem, peace evaporates and anxiety rushes in. The moment your mind returns to God, peace returns. Perfect peace is not the absence of problems — it is the presence of God in the middle of the problems.

3. Paul's Secret — Peace Through Prayer and Thanksgiving. Philippians 4:6-7 reveals Paul's formula for peace: Be careful for nothing (stop worrying), but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God — and THEN the peace of God will guard your heart and mind. The pathway to supernatural peace is prayer with thanksgiving. When you bring your anxieties to God and mix them

with thanksgiving — gratitude for what He has already done — you activate the peace that passes understanding.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, You said 'Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you.' Tonight I receive that peace. I cast every care and every anxiety upon You because You care for me. I choose to fix my mind on You and not on my circumstances. Let Your peace that passes understanding guard my heart and my mind right now. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that the peace of God guards my heart and my mind.
- ❖ I will not be anxious about anything.
- ❖ I cast every care upon Jesus because He cares for me.
- ❖ In the middle of every storm, I have supernatural peace.
- ❖ My mind is stayed on God and He keeps me in perfect peace.
- ❖ My home, my heart, and my mind overflow with God's peace.
- ❖ The peace of God that passes understanding is mine. Amen!

Scripture

"If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him." — James 1:5 (KJV)

The Word — “The Wisdom that Grace Provides”

Information is abundant. Knowledge is accessible. But wisdom — the ability to rightly apply knowledge, to make right decisions, to navigate complex situations with divine insight — wisdom is rare. Tonight on Day 13, we explore the grace of divine wisdom — the kind of wisdom that cannot be learned in any school but flows freely from the God who is wisdom itself.

1. God Gives Wisdom Liberally to All Who Ask. James 1:5 is one of the most generous promises in all of Scripture. Any of you — not just the highly educated, not just the spiritually mature, not just the clergy — ANY of you who lacks wisdom can simply ask God and He will give it. But notice how He gives — liberally, and without upbraiding. God does not give wisdom reluctantly. He does not remind you of your failures when you ask. He gives freely, generously, and without reproach. Divine wisdom is available to everyone — right now.

2. Divine Wisdom Vs Human Wisdom. This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish...But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits (James 3:15-17). Human wisdom is limited by information, experience, and perspective. Divine wisdom transcends all three. It gives you insight into situations your natural mind cannot fully comprehend. It produces decisions that lead to life, peace, and the fulfillment of God's purpose.

3. Wisdom in Every Area of Life. Solomon asked for wisdom and received it — and as a result, everything else he needed was added to him. Wisdom is the master key that unlocks every other door. Wisdom in your marriage produces a thriving relationship. Wisdom in business produces sustainable prosperity. Wisdom in ministry produces lasting fruit. Wisdom in parenting

produces godly children. When you have divine wisdom, you make the right choices — and right choices lead to right outcomes.

Prayer of Response

Father, according to Your Word, I ask for wisdom right now. I lack wisdom in certain areas of my life and I come to You — the God who gives to all liberally. Give me wisdom for my marriage, my business, my ministry, my parenting, and my finances. Let Your Spirit of wisdom rest upon me. Let me make decisions that honor You and advance Your Kingdom. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that I walk in the wisdom of God.
- ❖ I make decisions guided by divine insight and understanding.
- ❖ I am not moved by human reasoning alone — I am led by the Spirit.
- ❖ Wisdom flows through me like a river.
- ❖ Every decision I make in this season is seasoned with grace and wisdom.
- ❖ All the treasures of wisdom and knowledge are in Christ — and I am in Christ.
- ❖ I am wise with God's wisdom. In Jesus' name. Amen!

Prayer Points

The Word — “Connected to the Vine — Living a Life of Overflow”

From the very beginning of creation, God's mandate for humanity has been fruitfulness and multiplication. He said: Be fruitful and multiply. This mandate was not cancelled at the fall — it was redeemed at Calvary. Tonight on Day 14, we stand at the halfway point of our second week and declare that the grace of God produces fruitfulness and multiplication in every area of our lives.

1. Abiding in the Vine Is the Secret. Jesus gives us the ultimate formula for fruitfulness: Abide in Me. The branch does not produce fruit by effort — it produces fruit by connection. As long as the branch stays connected to the vine, fruit is the inevitable result. Your fruitfulness in life, ministry, business, and relationships is not primarily a product of your strategy — it is a product of your connection to Jesus Christ. When you abide in Him, fruit is not optional — it is automatic.

2. God's Original Mandate — Be Fruitful and Multiply. God's first words to humanity were a blessing: Be fruitful and multiply. This blessing has never been revoked. It was reaffirmed to Noah, to Abraham, to Isaac, to Jacob, and to Israel. And through Jesus Christ, it has been extended to every believer. You are not designed for barrenness — you are designed for fruitfulness. You are not created for stagnation — you are created for multiplication. The grace of God activates the original mandate over your life.

3. Fruit that Remains. Jesus said: Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain (John 15:16). God does not want temporary fruit — He wants lasting fruit. He does not want flash-in-the-pan successes — He wants sustainable fruitfulness. The grace of God produces fruit that

remains — children who walk with God, ministries that endure, businesses that sustain, and lives that create lasting legacy.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, I declare tonight that I am a fruitful branch connected to You — the True Vine. I refuse to accept barrenness in any area of my life. Every area is subject to Your multiplication grace. Let Your original mandate — be fruitful and multiply — be activated over my life today. Let me bear fruit that remains — fruit that brings glory to Your name. In Jesus' name. Amen.

The Word — “Free Indeed — The Total Liberation of Grace”

One of the most powerful statements Jesus ever made was: If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. Not partially free. Not temporarily free. Not conditionally free. FREE INDEED — completely, totally, permanently free. Tonight on Day 15, we explore the deliverance and freedom that grace provides — and declare that no child of God has to live in any form of bondage.

1. Jesus Came to Set Captives Free. In His first sermon, Jesus declared His mission statement: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised (Luke 4:18). Deliverance is not a side ministry of Jesus — it is a central part of His mission. He came specifically to free those who are captive.

2. The Truth that Sets Free. Jesus said: Ye shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free. Many people are in bondage not because of a lack of God's power but because of a lack of truth in their lives. Deception is the most powerful form of bondage. When you believe lies about yourself, about God, and about your situation — those lies keep you in chains. But when the truth of God's Word enters your heart and you truly know it, experience it, and live by it — freedom is the inevitable result.

3. Freedom Maintained By Standing Fast. Paul warns: Stand fast in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. Freedom must be maintained. The enemy will always try to re-entangle the delivered. He will bring back the old addiction. He will resurrect the old mindset. He will try to lure you back into the old patterns. Standing fast means actively resisting the pull back to bondage. It means

declaring your freedom daily, renewing your mind with the Word, and walking in the grace that sustains your liberty.

Prayer of Response

Father, in the name of Jesus, I declare my freedom tonight. I am delivered from every yoke of bondage. The Son has made me free — and I am free indeed. I declare that every chain over my life is broken. Every addiction is destroyed. Every generational curse is cancelled. Every spirit of captivity is expelled. I stand fast in the liberty that Christ has purchased for me. I will not return to bondage. I am free! In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that I am free by the grace of God.
- ❖ Every yoke of bondage is broken off my life today.
- ❖ I am delivered from every addiction, every generational curse, every limitation.
- ❖ The Son has made me free — I am free INDEED.

from situations that should have destroyed us. We worship You as the God of all deliverance. In Jesus' name. Amen.

2. **Deliverance from Addiction.** In the name of Jesus, we pray for complete deliverance for everyone in this congregation battling addiction — to substances, to ungodly behaviors, to toxic relationships. Let the power of Christ break every addictive chain tonight. Let this be the night of complete and lasting freedom. In Jesus' mighty name. Amen.
3. **Breaking Generational Curses.** Father, we come against every generational curse operating through our family lines. The Word — “Under His Shadow — Living in Divine Protection”

We live in an increasingly dangerous world. Violence, accidents, disease, and unexpected tragedy touch lives around us every day. But for the child of God who dwells in the secret place of the Most High, there is a supernatural covering that no natural force can penetrate. Tonight on Day 16, we declare that divine protection is not a privilege for a select few — it is a grace-covenant reality for every believer who dwells in the presence of God.

1. Dwelling in the Secret Place. The protection of Psalm 91 is not automatic for everyone — it is conditional on dwelling in the secret place of the Most High. The secret place is a place of intimate relationship with God. It is the place of prayer, worship, and the Word. It is not a physical location but a spiritual posture — a life lived in the conscious presence of God. The believer who makes God their habitual dwelling place — who lives in His presence, who walks in communion with Him — that believer has access to the full covering of Psalm 91.

2. The Comprehensive Nature of Divine Protection. Psalm 91 describes divine protection that is comprehensive: He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler (from traps and deceptions). He shall cover thee with his feathers (intimate covering). His truth shall be thy shield and buckler (protection from lies). Thou shalt not be afraid of the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day (protection from attack at any time). A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee (protection even when destruction is all around). This is total, comprehensive, all-encompassing protection.

3. Angelic Protection — God's Special Forces. He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways (Psalm 91:11). Angels are not mythological beings — they are real, powerful, divine agents assigned to protect the people of God. The angel of the LORD encampeth round about

them that fear him (Psalm 34:7). Right now, around every believer who fears God, there are angels encamped. You may not see them — but they are there. They are real. They are powerful. And they are assigned to keep you.

Prayer of Response

Father, I declare that I dwell in the secret place of the Most High and I abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I claim the protection of Psalm 91 over my life, my family, and my home. Let Your angels encamp around us. Let no evil befall us and no plague come near our dwelling. I trust You as my refuge and my fortress. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that I dwell in the secret place of the Most High.
- ❖ His shadow covers me and my household.
- ❖ No evil shall befall me. No plague shall come near my dwelling.
- ❖ His angels have charge over me — keeping me in all my ways.

The Word — “Your Testimony Is a Weapon”

Tonight on Day 17 — with just four days remaining in our 21-day journey — we focus on something that is both a spiritual weapon and a divine assignment: the testimony. Revelation 12:11 reveals that one of the three weapons by which the saints overcome the accuser of the brethren is the word of their testimony. Your testimony is not just a story — it is a sword.

1. The Power of a Testimony. A testimony does several things simultaneously: It glorifies God — every testimony is a declaration of His goodness and power. It builds faith in others — when people hear what God has done for you, their faith for their own situation is ignited. It defeats the enemy — Revelation 12:11 says testimonies are weapons of spiritual warfare. It creates a record of God's faithfulness — a memorial stone that you can return to in future seasons of doubt. Never minimize your testimony. What God has done for you is a gift not just for you but for everyone who hears it.

2. Breakthrough Is Yours By Grace. The word 'breakthrough' literally means to break through a barrier, a wall, or an obstruction that has been preventing progress. Every person in this room has a breakthrough waiting on the other side of a barrier. The barrier might be in your mind — a stronghold of unbelief. It might be in the natural — a circumstance or system that seems unmovable. But the grace of God is a supernatural force that breaks through every barrier. What seems immovable to natural effort is easily penetrated by the grace of God.

3. Declaring Your Testimony Before It Manifests. One of the most powerful aspects of faith is the ability to testify about something before it has happened in the natural. Abraham called those things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17). He gave glory to God before Isaac was born. He testified about a son while he was still childless. This is not deception — it is the language of faith. When you declare your

breakthrough before it manifests, you are speaking into the spirit realm and creating the conditions for your testimony to materialize.

Prayer of Response

Lord, I declare tonight that my testimony is coming. What I have been waiting for is about to manifest. The blood of Jesus and the word of my testimony are my weapons of victory. I declare my breakthrough before I see it. I give You glory in advance. Let this season produce the testimony You have been preparing for my life. In Jesus' name. Amen.

Daily Declarations

- ❖ I declare that my testimony is powerful and life-changing.
- ❖ The blood of Jesus has given me a story worth telling.
- ❖ My breakthrough is on its way.
- ❖ What seemed impossible is becoming possible by grace.
- ❖ I will not be silent — I will testify of God's goodness.
- ❖ My life is a living testimony of overflowing grace.

The Word — “The Church that Grace Built — Unstoppable and Unshakeable”

Tonight on Day 18, we turn our focus to something very close to the heart of God — the Church. Not a building. Not a denomination. Not a religious institution. But the living, breathing, Spirit-filled body of Christ that Jesus Himself said He would build. Tonight we pray for the Church — locally at CCC Bilehou Oshoffa Miracle Land Parish and globally across the body of Christ.

1. Jesus Is the Builder of the Church. I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH — Jesus said it and He means it. The Church belongs to Jesus. He is not a spectator in the building process — He is the architect, the foundation, and the builder. This means the Church is not dependent on any single human leader, any particular strategy, or any specific cultural moment. The Church is built by Jesus through the Holy Spirit and by His grace. When human effort fails, His building continues. When resources run out, His work does not stop.

2. The Gates of Hell Shall Not Prevail. This is one of the most powerful promises in Scripture. The gates of hell — all the power, strategy, and force of the enemy — shall not prevail against the Church. Note the language: gates are defensive. Hell is defending its territory against an advancing Church. The Church is not on the defensive — it is on the offensive. The Church is not retreating — it is advancing. Every prayer meeting is an advance. Every soul saved is a victory. Every new church planted is territory taken from the enemy.

3. The Grace of Unity in the Body. Psalm 133 declares: How good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity. And then it says: for there the LORD commanded the blessing. Unity is not just a nice ideal — it is the condition for commanded blessing. When the body of Christ walks in genuine love and unity, it creates the spiritual environment in

which God commands His blessing to flow. Division grieves the Holy Spirit and weakens the Church. Unity delights the Holy Spirit and empowers the Church.

Prayer of Response

Lord Jesus, we pray for Your Church tonight. We pray for CCC Bilehou Oshoffa Miracle Land Parish specifically. Let Your grace rest upon this house. Let Your Spirit fill this place. Let Your presence be our greatest asset. Build this church, Lord — according to Your design, for Your glory, and for the impact of Your Kingdom. In Jesus' name. Amen.

The Word — “Grace Upon Grace — The Life of Permanent Overflow”

Tonight is Day 20 — the penultimate night of our 21 Days of Overflowing Grace. Tomorrow we celebrate. But tonight, we receive the fullness of everything these 20 days have been building toward. John 1:16 declares: Of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace. Grace for grace — grace upon grace — grace replacing grace — an endless, inexhaustible, overflowing supply of God's grace that never runs out. Tonight we receive the overflow.

1. From His Fullness — The Inexhaustible Supply. Of his FULNESS have all we received. Not from His leftovers. Not from His overflow. From His FULNESS — the complete, total, inexhaustible fullness of the God who fills all in all. Ephesians 3:19 speaks of being filled with all the fullness of God. Think about what that means. The same God who created the universe, who sustains all things by the word of His power, who is infinite in every dimension — that God has made His FULNESS available to you. And from that fulness, we receive grace for grace.

2. Grace for Grace — Continuous Overflow. The phrase 'grace for grace' in the Greek literally means grace in place of grace — one wave of grace being replaced by another wave, even greater than the one before. Think of ocean waves. Just as one wave recedes, another is already coming. And each wave is potentially greater than the last. This is the pattern of God's grace in the life of a believer — it never stops coming. It is never exhausted. It is never diminished by how much you have already received. The more grace you receive, the more grace is available.

3. Abundant Life — The Purpose of Overflowing Grace. Jesus said: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. The word 'abundantly' in the Greek is 'perissos' — meaning beyond measure, exceeding, superabundant, more than enough. Jesus did not come

to give you a barely-sufficient life. He came to give you a life that overflows. A life that exceeds expectations. A life that surpasses the imagination. From Grace to Grace — every day of your life is meant to be characterized by the overflow of God's abundant grace.

Prayer of Response

Father, I declare that I have received grace upon grace from the fullness of God. This is not the end — it is the beginning of my overflow. Everything I have prayed for these 20 days is established in the spirit. From grace to grace I go. My overflow is permanent, my breakthrough is lasting. I receive the abundant life You came to give me. Let me never go back to barely enough when You have prepared overflow. In Jesus' name. Amen.
